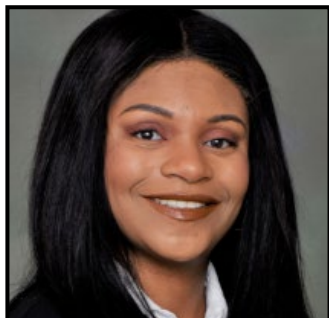
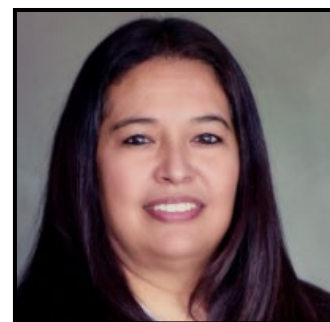


Welcome to the Office! ---
